This program is approved by the NH Mechanical Licensing Board and is designed to be a self study program with frequent assessments that will be proctored for integrity purposes. Each participant must have access to a laptop or desktop computer with microphone and camera capability. Tablets/phones will not be sufficient for taking assessment quizzes and tests.

Steps to enrollment:

to enroll at NCCER Connect (Pearson) to gain the access to the on line e-learning platform. When asked, you will NOT be using an LMS, so you will need the below course numbers.

You will need the following course numbers to enroll in your course year:

When asked for an access code you will click on the 14 day trial session to ensure you like the program. Once that trial period expires, the instructor will email you the access code to make your access permanent.
